- 1. Have a volunteer read Mark 12:35-44.
- 2. In verses 35-37, what puzzle did Jesus give for the scribes to solve? What were the two unacceptable choices the scribes had to choose from in responding to Jesus?
- 3. How did Jesus' handling of Psalm 110:1 add to the people's understanding of who the Messiah was? Why do you think the crowds were receptive to this revelation?
- 4. According to verses 38-40, what motivated the Sadducees' practice of religion? What were they willing to do in order to maintain their positions of religious power?
- 5. What did Jesus say would be the consequence of that behavior?
- 6. Read Mark 12:41-44. How was the woman's giving an illustration of how the religious leaders "devoured widows houses"?
- 7. Pastor Brian noted that it was unlikely that Jesus was praising the widow giving her tithe to a corrupt religious system that he was about to destroy. Instead, he pointed out the widow's giving to highlight the injustice of the religious leaders.
- 8. What are some ways religious games harm innocent people today?
- 9. Why do you think Jesus was comfortable in openly denouncing his opponents at this phase of his ministry?
- 10. In verse 43, Jesus contrasts the woman's worship with that of the Sadducees. Even though she was misguidedly funding a hopelessly broken religious system, how was her faith superior to that of the religious leaders?
- 11. How can we avoid "playing church" in a way that hurts others?
