4. How do you know who to pray for? How do you typically decide that?
5. Do you have a story of how God answered a prayer after someone praying specifically for you?
6. Who should you pray for?
7. Is there ever a time you shouldn't pray for someone?
8. What has been your biggest takeaway from this series?
