Life Group Discussion

Encouragement: In the popular book written by L.M. Montgomery, “Anne of Green Gables”, the main character of the story says: “I’m so glad I live in a world where there are October’s.” We had a particularly beautiful October this year in Erie County. Share a highlight of your October with the group, and ask a few others to share as well.

Scripture: [John 14:6](#)

1. In this week’s sermon, Pastor Sarah taught that God’s remedy for this broken world is Jesus and as followers of Jesus, we are part of the work of restoration. What is significant about the words Jesus uses to describe himself?
2. According to this scripture how do you get to the Father? What does that look like in your life, to “come to the Father through me”?
3. How can we take the words and truth in that scripture and take it out into this broken and hurting world when we are interacting with other people?

Prayer: Have a group member read [Psalm 84:11](#) as the opening of the prayer. After the verse is read, have someone in the group pray that God’s goodness and mercy would be evident in everyone’s life, and that we would be a living example as go about our lives.

Next Steps: Encourage the group members to make intentional time to get to know God better this week by reading scripture and spending time in prayer.
